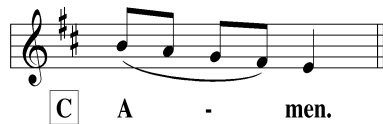
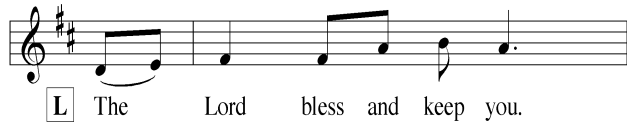
## PRAYER FOR GRACE
