PRAYER OF THE DAY

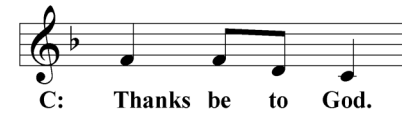

PRAYER FOR GRACE

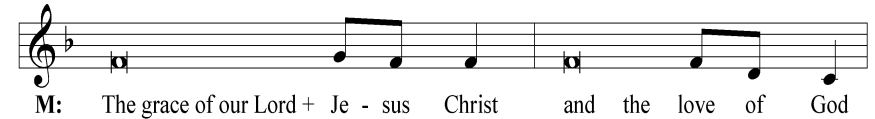
