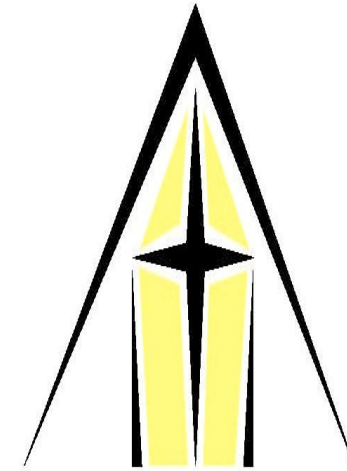

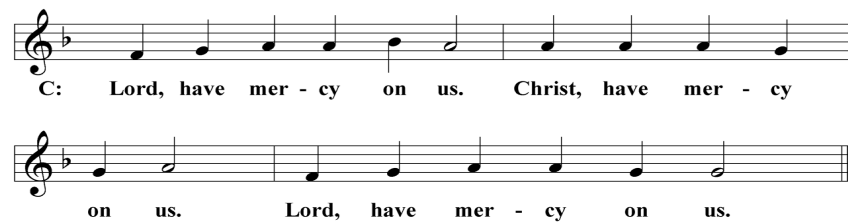
M: In the name of the Father and of the (+) Son and of the Holy Spirit.

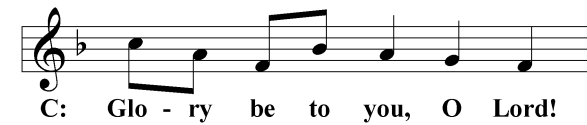

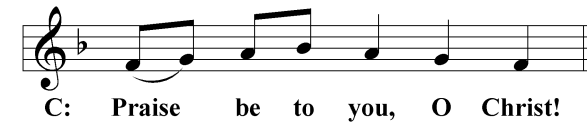
