

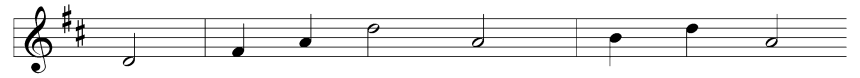
The Lord's My Shepherd
