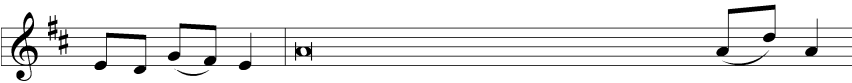

great God and a great king a - bove all gods. The deep places of the earth are



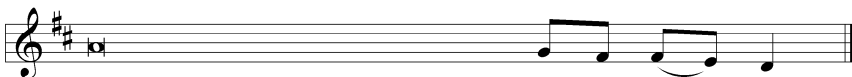
in his hand; the heights of the hills are al - so his. The sea is his, for he

forever and ever. Amen.

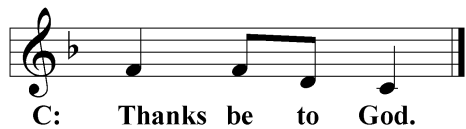
## PRAYER OF THE DAY

## PRAYER FOR GRACE

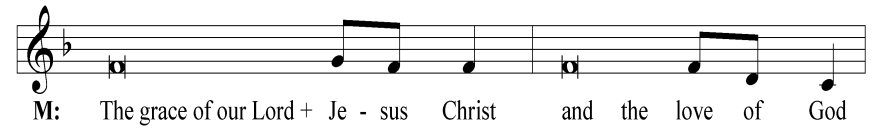
